The role will be responsible to supervisor staff as required (back-up). This position will be working all shifts and is dependent on seasonal volumes. Shift schedules are under review and subject to change depending on production needs., including shift rotation and/or shift change.

- Set up applicable packaging equipment at the beginning of each shift to ensure proper working order
- Maintain and clean packaging equipment before and after each shift as required
- Monitor packaging equipment during every procedure to ensure optimum running
- Monitor canning equipment and work with maintenance to troubleshoot problems during production hours
- Ensure that regular and preventative maintenance procedures are carried out
- Ensure that safety devices are functioning at all times on packaging equipment
- Ensure that packaging equipment is producing quality products by managing periodic checks on output
- Provide training to all applicable Filler Operators

- Actively lead by example and display a proactive approach to all health & safety policy & procedures
- Maintain activity logs
