Packaging Activities Include

- Work all areas of bottling, canning and keging lines

- Inspecting the quality of raw materials, the products throughout the packaging process, and the finished goods.
- Conduct off-line duties such as sub-assembly, production preparations, special packaging assembly, and preparing the finished goods for the warehouse
- Examine products to verify conformity to quality standards
- Lift raw materials, finished products and packed items manually or using hoists Kegs / Casks Cleaning and Filling activities include:
- Learn, understand and operate the keg washer or perform keg filling as per the standard operating procedures
- Troubleshoot the keg washer as required
- Complete packaging reports as required

- Must be able to work shift rotations to respond to increased demands
